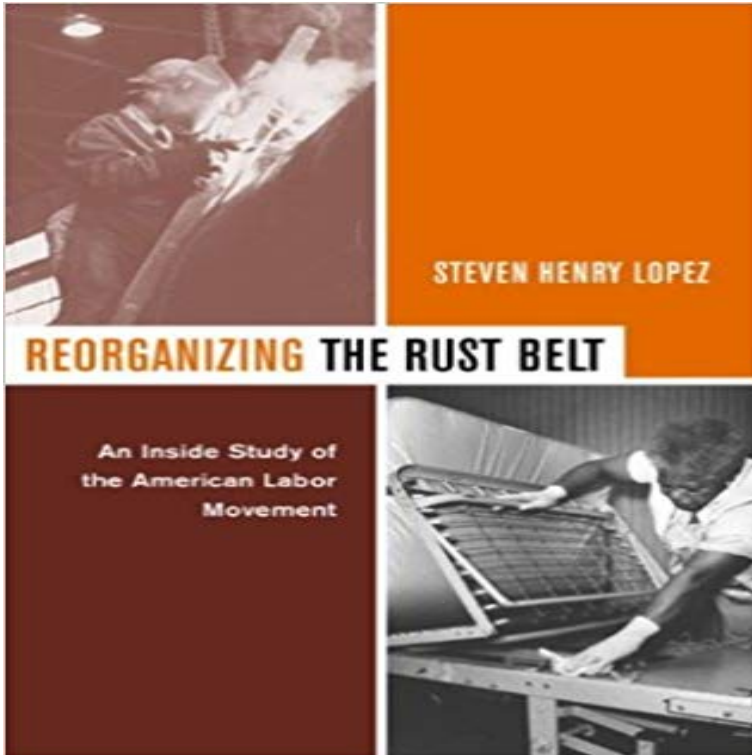


Reorganizing the Rust Belt: An Inside Study of the American Labor Movement

Lopez shows how the unions ability to devise creative solutions rather than the adoption of specific tactics makes the difference between success and failure.
